IEEE Oceanic Engineering Society Workshop Marine Litter: Solutions for a Cleaner Ocean

28-29 September 2022 at Pôle Numérique Brest Iroise in Brest, France

The 2022 workshop is a follow-up of the first two Brest workshops in 2018 and 2019 on “Technologies for observing and monitoring plastics in the oceans” and “Marine Debris Indicators: What’s Next?”

This year’s participatory workshop will focus on options for preventing and mitigating marine debris in general and plastic in the ocean in particular. Bringing together a wide range of stakeholders, we will identify priority actions for a cleaner ocean and integrate these actions into the road map developed during the first two workshops.
